All-year round. Closed all day on New Year's Day, Easter Sunday, August 15 and Christmas day.






For a long time renowned as being the third largest unsupported dome in the world, the gigantic rotunda church is decorated with many paintings by Giuseppe Calì and other able artists. Dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, one should not miss going into the sacristies, to view and admire the various objects of prestige, including a replica of the bomb, paintings and a large-scale model of the church. A visit to the inner balcony is also included in the ticket. Afterwards, you can visit the preserved shelter from World War 2 - a genuine experience, truly not to be missed!






Exclusive after-hours tours of the church, Duration: 1 hour

Christmas in Mosta




10 December 2023 to 6 January 2024














The Dome Visitors Centre
